By planning lessons and choosing spelling words that correspond with a theme, students are provided ample opportunities to read and write the spelling words prior to the test while also learning about science. Please note that there is a corresponding social studies book sold separately and that together the two books provide a list of spelling words for nearly every sound in the English language, including the short vowel sounds, long vowel sounds, vowel digraphs, diphthongs, r-controlled vowels, consonant sounds, syllabic l, and the consonant digraphs. The chart with the table of contents lists each theme, the emphasized sound for the theme, and the spelling patterns that make the sound. For example, the long e sound is studied during a theme on Growing Up Healthy in the science book, and the spelling patterns taught are ea as in peach, ee as in sleep, y as in dairy, and ey as in honey. There are 36 lessons included in the science book. The lessons come with a spelling word search, a set of spelling word flashcards, and worksheets and activities to help students learn about alphabetizing, contextual analysis, phonics, homophones, prefixes and suffixes, compound words, parts of speech, penmanship and writing skills. (These are the SECONDARY OBJECTIVES.) Throughout the book, you will also find ideas for integrating art, math, and geography into the themes. At the end of most lessons, there is a multiple-choice science test with bubbles to fill in that can be used to assess individual learning. The same exams are also available online as computer-based tests. To help prepare students for the tests, there are a set of question cards to use for unit games. The Teacher's edition of this book with answer keys is sold separately.

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
