The term "Fascist" never appears in Mein Kampf as a self-description by Hitler. 9. The term "swastika" never appears in the original Mein Kampf. 10. There is no evidence that Hitler ever used the word "swastika." 11. The symbol that Hitler did use was intended to represent "S"-letter shapes for "socialist." 12. THE LATEST SWASTIKA DISCOVERIES: Hitler's symbol is the reason why Hitler renamed his political party from DAP to NSDAP - National Socialist German Workers Party - because he needed the word Socialist in his party's name so that Hitler could use swastikas as S-letter shaped logos for SOCIALIST as the party's emblem.
